STUDENT SUPPORT SCHEME APPLICATION GUIDANCE NOTES

Eligibility

The scheme is open to receive applications from students (and trainees) of all ages undertaking vocational study/training in agricultural and allied land-based subjects.

Preference will be given to applications received from persons normally resident within the usual catchment area of the Gillingham & Shaftesbury Show (which includes substantial parts of the counties of Dorset, Wiltshire and Somerset).

Applications may be made for financial help with any element/aspect of the applicant's study/training (awards will normally be subject to an upper limit of £1500). Only one application is permitted per applicant per 12 month period.

Shortlisted applicants may be invited to speak with a Member of the Student Support Fund Committee to fully understand the merits of the application.

All successful awards shall be conditional upon the applicant agreeing to repay, in full or in part, any funds not utilised for the purposes awarded. Such condition may, for example, be invoked if an applicant fails to gain a place on their chosen course of study/ training or fails to maintain that place for its full duration.
